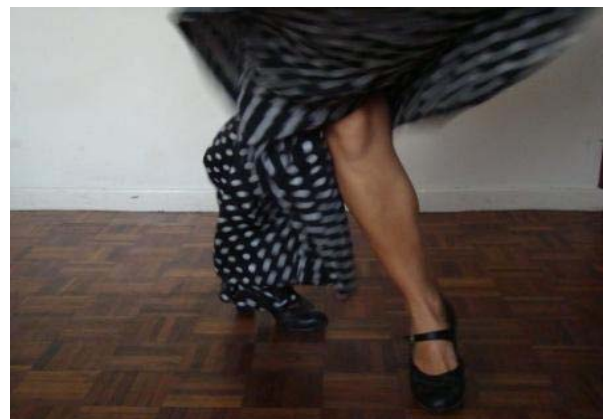

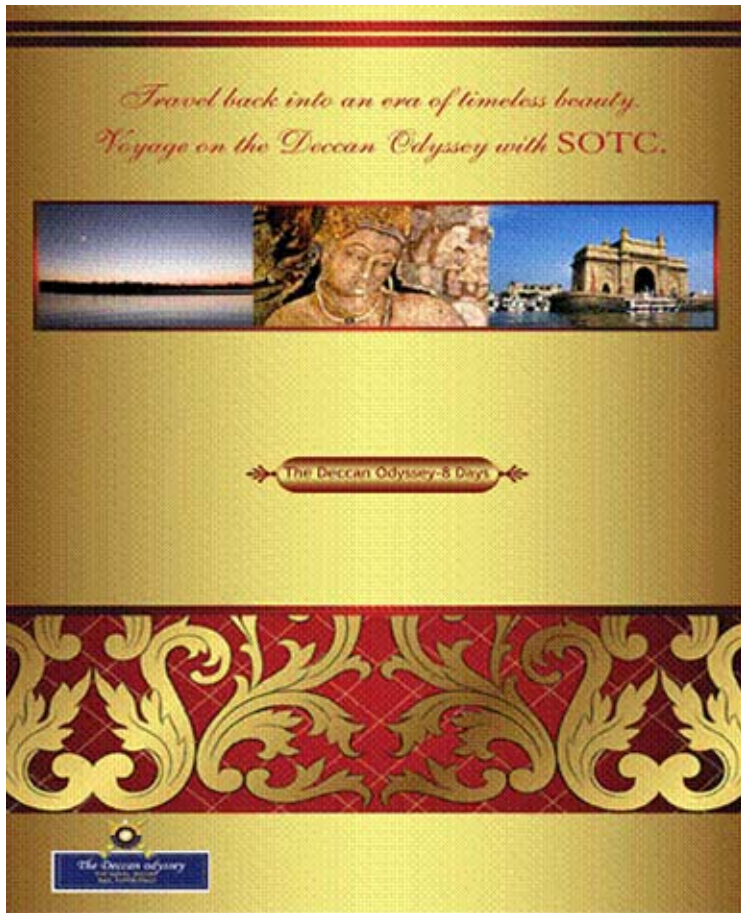

WORKSHOP—CORPORATE AND TAX COMPLIANCE: 25th and 26th March

(One day in English and one day in Portuguese). This Workshop will also incorporate a Module on the rules for hiring foreign employees. We will limit this Workshop to 35 Participants to ensure maximum interaction with the Presenters, Sam Levy and Eduardo Calú from SAL & Caledira.

Another important matter to note is that the Ministry of Finance has informed the public that its previously stated plan for the introduction of International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) in Mozambique is still on target. According to this plan, from 1st January 2010, IFRS must be adopted by all large Corporations in Mozambique. From 1st January 2011, IFRS must be adopted by all medium Corporations in Mozambique. IFRS requires that comparative figures must be restated and presented in accordance with IFRS in the first year of implementation. This means that, in effect, IFRS implementation will affect the accounting information collected a year before the dates set in the Ministry's plan.

In order to prepare for the introduction of IFRS, intensive training will be necessary for all accountants and auditors working in both the Private Sector and the Regulatory Bodies. Columbanus is pleased to present a series of Workshops throughout 2009 to assist organizations to prepare for the transition to IFRS. We will bring in Pedro Quelhas from Portugal to present the Portuguese speaking Workshops. Pedro is a "Revisor Oficial de Contas" in Portugal (ROC) and has an extensive knowledge of IFRS. Bruce Mackenzie and his team from W Consulting in Johannesburg will return to Mozambique to run the English speaking Workshops. Bruce is a South African Chartered Accountant and is one of the most experienced IFRS Trainers in Southern Africa.

The Introduction to IFRS Workshop on the 16th April (Half Day Workshop) will be presented in English and is designed for the top executives of the major corporations. The Workshop will provide a background on IFRS and will outline the main principles of IFRS and some of the implications of first time implementation of IFRS. The IFRS Technical Updates (Half Day Workshops in English) are designed for Financial Managers/Auditors who already have a good working knowledge of IFRS. The update will review all the major changes and developments in IFRS. The 2 Day Intensive Workshops will be presented in Portuguese and are designed to provide full and detailed Training on IFRS. The Workshops will start in April, with a two day Intensive Introduction to IFRS. This Workshop will cover each of the standards and will provide a background on the Standard and an overview of the application of the Standard. The subsequent Workshops will be of a duration of 2 Days. Each Workshop will cover 6 individual Standards and will work through each Standard, with practical examples and calculations. These Workshops are designed to provide Participants with a thorough understanding of the Standards covered in the Workshop. This series of Workshops will have covered 36 Standards in detail by the close of the year. We will limit these workshops to 35 Participants to ensure maximum interaction with the Presenter. We will run each Workshops twice (in one week), as we expect the demand to be very high for these Workshops.

General Information

Title: Communications Consultant

Contract period: initially 3 months, to start as soon as possible

Background

The World Food Programme Mozambique Country Office (CO) is recruiting a Communications Consultant to help coordinate the internal and external communications activities of the CO, including media and donor relations, public information and reporting.

In support to the Country Director, the Public Information and Reports Unit is the focal point for media and donor relations and plays an active role in CO resource mobilization efforts. The PIR Unit oversees the production of external information pieces, including press releases, operational updates and a wide variety of specialized briefs, presentations and reports for donors, VIPs and media. The Unit organizes and leads field visits for donors and media and is responsible for drafting all funding proposals and related reports.

The PIR Unit produces a variety of reports, including the annual Standard Project Reports, monthly Executive Briefs, regular emergency updates, financial tracking inputs (ODAMoz), consolidated sub-office sitreps and meeting minutes.

The PIR Unit also represents WFP in the UN Communications Group (UNCG) – as part of the ongoing “Delivering as One” UN reform initiative in Mozambique – and is actively engaged in a number of joint communications activities, including as Lead of the UN Mozambique website (www.unmozambique.org).

Supervision

The Communications Consultant will be directly supervised by the Deputy Country Director.

Duties and Responsibilities

Within delegated authority, the Communications Consultant will be responsible for the following duties:

- Assist the Country Director/Deputy Country Director in meeting the funding needs of WFP operations in Mozambique through the preparation of donor appeals and reports;
- Compile field level information required for operational reports to donors;
- Monitor and review regular sources of information and data required for preparation of reports, e.g., information from NGOs, news clippings, surveys, information from field monitors, food statistics reports;
- Coordinate the preparation, writing and editing of all reports required by Headquarters, including monthly Executive Briefs and regular emergency situation reports as needed;
- Act as public information focal point;
- Produce press releases, media briefs, talking points, donor visibility materials, photographic/video pieces and other advocacy materials;
- Develop and update a general CO brochure and a comprehensive information kit;
- Ensure active participation (eight hours per week) by WFP in the UN Communication Group;
- Organize and accompany donor/media visits to WFP operations;
- Meet with in-country donors and coordinate events and ceremonies to recognize significant contributions;
- Perform other duties as may be required.

Minimum Qualifications

Education: University degree with relevant experience or advanced training/courses in communications, social sciences, development economics, business administration, international relations, or a field relevant to international development assistance.

Experience: At least five years of postgraduate progressively responsible professional experience in international development, donor aid programmes, communications and/or emergency assistance; previous experience with fundraising, negotiations, public relations/advocacy and work experience within the private sector are an asset.

Knowledge: Experience using computers, including word processing, spreadsheets and other software packages. Knowledge of WFP administrative regulations and rules, and WFP policies and procedures in the area of work.

Language: Oral and written fluency in English (proficiency/Level C) and limited knowledge of Portuguese or another official WFP language, i.e., Arabic, French, Spanish (intermediate/Level B).

Desirable Skills and/or Experience: Extensive English writing background in a humanitarian environment preferred. Working knowledge (Level C) of Portuguese language, the Mozambique context and the UN system desired. Web development skills. Ability to use digital video and still cameras an asset. Ability to meet deadlines and remain cool under pressure. Ability to work in a multicultural environment as part of a team and on your own.
